<p><b>Alwyn Ellwood Adamthwaite</b> OLIVE line</p>	<p>(source Nat. Archives of Australia). Service no NX207524, enlisted Paddington NSW, next of kin John Adamthwaite <i>Born 30 may 1927, Newcastle, NSW, son of John and Ethel (Smith), died 2004</i></p>	
<p><b>Bill, Joe, John and Victor Adamthwaite</b> GREY line</p>	<p>Toronto Adamthwaites, <i>all sons of Joseph and Lizzie (Wakelyn):</i> <i>William James, born 1914</i> <i>Joseph, born 1917</i> <i>John – Arthur John?, born 1923</i> <i>Victor Verdun, born 1916, died 1967</i></p>	
<p><b>Charles Frederick Adamthwaite</b> YELLOW line</p>	<p>Charles joined the army during the general strike of 1926 and served as a Corporal in the East Surrey Regiment. When he was stationed at Fort Regent, St Helier, Jersey, he met Alice Maria Brown and they were married there in 1926. Alice was nanny to the children of the Captain of Charles's regiment. During WW2 Charles served in the Home Guard in Southall.  <i>Son of Charles Frederick and Florence (Woodroffe) born 1904, died 1997</i></p>	
<p><b>Charlie Adamthwaite</b> TURQUOISE line</p>	<p>Not found any record of service, but in photo he is in uniform – we believe this may have been that of the Home Guard? <i>Son of William and Mary Ann (Watson) born 1886, died 1949</i></p>	
<p><b>Clarence Joseph Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no VX37213, enlisted Royal Park, Victoria, next of kin Arthur Adamthwaite <i>Born 20 dec 1904 Swan Hill, Victoria, son of Arthur Joseph and Mabel (Smith), died 1982</i></p>	
<p><b>David Clive Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no V125025, 29<sup>th</sup> Battalion, enlisted Brunswick, Vic, next of kin Alma Adamthwaite <i>Born 4 jul 1919 at Wonthaggi, Vic, son of Albert Charles and Alma Vida (Blake)</i></p>

<p><b>Fred Adamthwaite</b> OLIVE line</p>	<p><i>Son of John Thomas Adamthwaite and Mary Jane (Johns) born 1915, died 1968</i></p>	
<p><b>Frederic Gordon Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no VX106376, enlisted, in the field, next of kin Frederic Adamthwaite <i>Born 6 mar 1909 Zeehan, Tasmania, son of Frederick Smith Adamthwaite and Lucy (Bound), died 1980</i></p>	
<p><b>Hazel Taylor (nee Adamthwaite)</b></p>	<p>(source NatArchives of Australia) service no NX207524, enlisted Paddington, NSW, next of kin Frances Adamthwaite <i>Born 17 feb 1922, Newcastle NSW, dau of Francis and Janet (Ruddy)</i></p>	
<p><b>Jack Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no N413250, enlisted Lambton, NSW, next of kin John Adamthwaite <i>Born 9 feb 1924, Newcastle, NSW, son of ? – this could be John H Adamthwaite, son of John H and Ethel (Smith)</i></p>	
<p><b>Jack Adamthwaite</b> VIOLET line</p> 	<p>(source CWGC) Signalman in Royal Corps of Signals (no 2389896) Killed in action – buried at Cassino War Cemetery, Italy on 3 dec 1943 age 37 <i>Son of Richard and Jane Eliza (Bedford) b 1906, died 1943</i></p>	
<p><b>James Adamthwaite jr</b> OLIVE line</p>	<p><i>Son of John Thomas Adamthwaite and Mary Jane (Johns) born 1912, died 1993</i></p>	
<p><b>Joan Adamthwaite</b> OLIVE line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no NF446726) enlisted Paddington NSW, next of kin Francis Adamthwaite <i>Born 29 oct 1923 Newcastle, NSW, daughter of Francis and Janet (Ruddy), died 2006</i></p>	
<p><b>John Cromwell Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line</p>	<p>(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no. 410799, next of kin Emily Adamthwaite <i>Born 23 jan 1912 –son of Frederick Smith Adamthwaite and Lucy (Bound) – he married an Emily Ferguson</i></p>

<b>Maurice Edmund Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line	(source Nat. Archives of Australia) service no 5274 <i>Born 24 jan 1906 in Queenstown, Tasmania, son of Frederick smith Adamthwaite and Lucy (Bound), died bef 1978</i>	
<b>Norman James Adamthwaite</b> YELLOW line	(source London Gazette) (reg.no 330272) to be 2 <sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant, Royal Corps of Signals, 1944. To be Captain, 1948. From Active List to retain his seniority, 1954. Ceased to belong to T A Res. Of Officers 1960, having exceeded the age limit. <i>Son of Percy Norman and Amy (Parrish) born 1910, died 1962</i>	
<b>Stanley William Adamthwaite</b> YELLOW line	(source London Gazette/FMP) (no. 968293) Lance Sergeant S W Adamthwaite. Mentioned in Dispatches 24 8 1944 for action in Italy – file 68/gen/7896 <i>Son of Cyril Ernest and Bessie (Young) born 1919, died 1995</i>	
<b>Thomas Almond Adamthwaite</b>	(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no NX45738, enlisted Newcastle NSW, next of kin Thomas Adamthwaite <i>Born 22 sep 1919 Newcastle, NSW, not sure who this is</i>	
<b>Thomas Christopher Adamthwaite</b> TEAL line	(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no VX118954, next of kin Fred Adamthwaite. <i>Born 21 mar 1923 Queenstown Tasmania, son of Frederick Smith Adamthwaite and Lucy (Bound)</i>	
<b>Thomas Adamthwaite</b> ?VIOLET line	(source London Gazette) (no. 188092) RAF Volunteer Reserve, Pilot Officer to be Flight Officer, April 1945. Flying Officer retaining rank, May 1957. <i>Could be son of Robert and Georgina (Molyneux), born 1912</i>	
<b>Thomas Adamthwaite RUDD</b>	(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no WX29184, enlisted Gin Gin, WA, next of kin Rudd J <i>Born 28 sep 1921, Donnybrook WA</i>	
<b>Tom Adamthwaite</b> VIOLET line	(source London Gazette) (reg. no. 313762) To be 2 <sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant in 1944 <i>Son of Thomas and Ellen (Walker) born 1904, died 1965</i>	
<b>Vestal Adamthwaite</b> OLIVE line	(source Nat Archives of Australia) service no NX50906, enlisted Paddington, NSW, next of kin Lily Adamthwaite <i>Born 21 jul 1920 Newcastle, NSW, son of Elizabeth Adamthwaite, married to Lila Hodge in 1949, died 2000</i>	
<b>William John Adamthwaite</b> YELLOW line	Was a Prisoner of the Japanese and worked on the infamous Burma Railroad. <i>Son of Charles Frederick and Florence Woodroffe, born 1914, died 1983</i>
